Dear President Matt Adams and Directors:

The San Carlos Area Council (SCAC), at their bi-monthly meeting on November 5, 2014, with a Quorum of Directors present, had the following item on its agenda, as requested by NCPI at its September 15, 2014 meeting:

In an effort to ease the parking situation at the Cowles Mtn. Trailhead at Navajo Rd. and Golfcrest Dr., the SCAC Directors will consider comments from residents and the public and make a recommendation to the NCPI Board on all or most of the following solutions: (1) Removal of the red curb on Golfcrest Dr., across from the trailhead, and restriping Golfcrest Dr. near Navajo Rd. to create 17 parallel-parking spaces. (2) Highlighting and encouraging the use of the San Carlos Library lower parking lot, on weekends only, to add 30 spaces that are not normally used during hours the library is closed. Mission Trails Regional Park will add signs informing hikers about this added parking location (3) Add additional red curbing around homes on Melotte, Birchcreek, and Golfcrest (including the cul-de-sacs).

Four residents and several Directors voiced opposition to the removal of red curbing and subsequent restriping for an additional 17 parallel parking spaces on Golfcrest Dr. One spoke in favor and asked for a 200-space parking lot to be constructed on park property along Navajo Rd.

After public comment was closed, a Motion to keep the red curbing on Golfcrest Dr. was made and seconded. SCAC Directors voted unanimously in favor of the Motion to retain the existing red curbing on Golfcrest Dr. The other issues were not the subject of a vote, since the red curbing at individual residences is an issue to be worked out between residents and the Traffic Dept. In addition, we encouraged Jay Wilson, the MTRP representative at the meeting, to suggest to MTRP that the publicity for the additional spaces in the library parking lot, on weekends only, occur as soon as possible. We also thanked the San Carlos Library Manager, Rita Glick, for her cooperation and for allowing parking to occur in the lot on weekends.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the SCAC Directors that the red curbing on Golfcrest Dr. near Navajo Rd. be retained, as the residents requested. We ask that this recommendation be considered by the NCPI Board at their November 17, 2014 meeting, when the Action Item is on their agenda, and that this letter be made a part of the official record for the meeting.

Thank you for the opportunity to provide input to the NCPI Board on this issue.
